Mr. Ostrowski explained the options at this point; to move ahead with the second candidate, defer any decision to the new Council and/or continue to search. Mr. Ostrowski made a motion to table the decision to hire a Borough Manager for the new Council coming onboard next week. Mr. Bailey seconded the motion. With no further discussions the motion passed by a unanimous voice vote.


