

2013 - Executive Summary

For the year 2013 the Borough of Millersville experienced a 7.89% (12) decrease in reported major serious crimes (Part One Crimes), from 152 reported in 2012 to 140 reported in 2013. Of the 140 reported major crimes, 41 (29.30%) have been cleared to date. This clearance rate should keep Millersville comparable to the County, State and National clearance averages. In addition, our Department handled 423 reported Part Two Crimes (less serious crimes) during 2013. Of the 423 reportable Part Two Crimes in 2013, 322 have been cleared to date, giving the Borough a 2013 Part Two clearance rate of 76.13%. When combining both Part One and Part Two Crimes, Millersville handled a total of 563 total criminal offenses during 2013. Of the 563 total criminal offenses handled during 2013, 363 cases have been cleared to date, giving Millersville a combined crime clearance rate of 64.5%.
