

2014 - Executive Summary

For the year 2014 the Borough of Millersville experienced a 9.5% (13) decrease in reported major serious crimes (Part One Crimes), from 137 reported in 2013 to 124 reported in 2014. Of the 124 reported major crimes, 56 (45.2%) have been cleared to date. This clearance rate should keep Millersville comparable to the County, State and National clearance averages. In addition, our Department handled 479 reported Part Two Crimes (less serious crimes) during 2014 which is an increase of 50 or 11.7% when compared to 2013. Of the 479 reportable Part Two Crimes in 2014, 382 have been cleared to date, giving the Borough a 2014 Part Two clearance rate of 79.75%. When combining both Part One and Part Two Crimes, Millersville handled a total of 603 total criminal offenses during 2014, which is an increase of 37 (6.5%) when compared to the total reported crime in 2013. Of the 603 total criminal offenses handled during 2014, 438 cases have been cleared to date, giving Millersville a combined crime clearance rate of 72.7%. During 2014 our officers handled 3057 calls requiring reports, which is an increase of 997 (48.4%) when compared to the 2060 calls requiring reports in 2012.
