

2015 - Executive Summary

For the year 2015 the Borough of Millersville experienced a 1.7% (2) increase in reported major serious crimes (Part One Crimes), from 114 reported in 2014 to 116 reported in 2015. Of the 116 reported major crimes, 40 (34.48%) have been cleared to date. This clearance rate should keep Millersville above the County, State and National clearance averages. In addition, our Department handled 425 reported Part Two Crimes (less serious crimes) during 2015 which is a decrease of 88 or 17.16% when compared to 2014. Of the 425 reportable Part Two Crimes in 2015, 318 have been cleared to date, giving the Borough a 2015 Part Two clearance rate of 74.83%. When combining both Part One and Part Two Crimes, Millersville handled a total of 541 total criminal offenses during 2015. Of the 541 total criminal offenses handled during 2015, 358 cases have been cleared to date, giving Millersville a combined crime clearance rate of 66.2%. During 2015 our officers handled 3164 calls requiring reports, which is an increase of 107 (3.5%) when compared to the 3057 calls requiring reports in 2014.
