

2016 - Executive Summary

Millersville handled a total of 542 total criminal offenses during 2016, which is an increase of 1 over the 541 total criminal offenses reported in 2015. For the year 2016 the Borough of Millersville experienced a 21.6% (25) decrease in reported major serious crimes (Part One Crimes), from 116 reported in 2015 to 91 reported in 2016. Of the 91 reported major crimes, 41 (45.10%) have been cleared to date. This clearance rate should keep Millersville above the County, State and National clearance averages. In addition, our Department handled 451 reported Part Two Crimes (less serious crimes) during 2016 which is an increase of 26 or 6.12% when compared to the 425 reported in 2015. Of the 451 reportable Part Two Crimes in 2016, 355 have been cleared to date, giving the Borough a 2016 Part Two clearance rate of 78.72%. Of the 542 total criminal offenses handled during 2016, 396 cases have been cleared to date, giving Millersville a combined crime clearance rate of 73.06%. During 2016 our officers handled 3,838 calls requiring reports, which is an increase of 674 (21.3%) when compared to the 3,164 calls requiring reports in 2015. It should also be noted that we saw increases of: 16% (23) in traffic accidents and 6.2% (24) in total arrests over the previous year.
