

The Millersville University Police Department is offering free drug drop-offs at their office, located at 237 North George Street (Lebanon House), to Millersville Borough residents and MU students. Prescriptions, prescription patches, medications, prescription ointments, vitamins, samples and pet medication are all acceptable. Intravenous solutions, injectables, needles, hydrogen peroxide, inhalers, aerosol cans, thermometers and ointments, lotions and liquids are not, and will not be accepted. The drop-off box helps provide a safe, environmentally friendly way to dispose of medications that otherwise could end up in our water supply. The most accessible hours are weekdays, M-F (8:00am-4:30pm), when the University Police lobby is open. The University will accept off-hour drop-offs, but a resident or student will need to call the information desk to have an officer open the lobby. Parking is available, at the rear of the Lebanon House. The University information desk phone number is 717-872-3011. The process does not involve forms or waiting in line, just simply approach the MedReturn box in the University Police lobby and put your medications inside—no questions, no forms and no meeting with any officers or staff.
