**Call To Order**

Chair Anthony Hightower called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

**Swearing in**

Commission Member (CM) Jeffrey Rambish, Alternate Member, was sworn in by Mayor Philip Lastowski.

**Approval of Minutes**

CM Mary Lyons made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from January 19, 2026. CM Judy Anttonen seconded, all voted yes.

**Old Business**

Remove 2 candidates from the eligibility list that declined to accept conditional offers. The number one candidate is now Daniel Gonzales and he accepted the conditional offer of employment and moves through the hiring process.

CM Anthony Hightower made a motion to update the eligibility list and clear both candidates that declined their conditional offers and add candidate Malcom Jenkins to the eligibility list. CM Mary Lyons seconded the motion, all voted yes.

Pending the favorable outcome of his polygraph test that is scheduled for February 18<sup>th</sup>, CM Mary Lyons will make a request at the February 24<sup>th</sup> Borough Council meeting to grant approval to make a conditional offer to Malcom Jenkins.

## **New Business**

Clear eligibility list and open for new candidates. CM Mary Lyons made a motion that we request Borough Council to advertise for applicants and limit acceptance to those who have completed Act 120 or will be certified for Act 120 by date of hire, to reestablish our eligibility list. CM Anthony Hightower seconded, all voted yes.

CM Debra Sweda contacted CM Anthony Hightower to announce her intention to resign from her alternate position. She is expected to send a letter to Borough Council to make her request. Upon receiving her resignation, the Borough office will advertise for a new alternate member.
