COUNCIL ACTION ITEMS

Crossgates Phase 2 Construction Discussion

Andy Boxleitner presented an overview of a previous meeting with Murray Construction that involves a redrawing of the original Crossgates Phase 2 development. The reason for this change is that the developer presented hammerhead street endings (dead end) and not cul de sac endings. The current drawings prevent the Borough from receiving Liquid Fuels Money. The State allocates the funds and certain requirements must be met.

The Municipal Liquid Fuels Program funds a range of projects to support the construction, reconstruction, maintenance, and repair of public roads or streets.

The amount of a municipality's allocation is based on its population and miles of roads on its approved liquid fuels inventory. To be placed on the system, a road must have a minimum of 33-foot right-of-way in a township and 16 feet in a borough. The "cartway" (drivable surface) must be a minimum width of 16 feet, and the road must be a minimum of 250 feet in length. **If the road is a dead-end, it must have a cul de sac (turnaround) at the end with a minimum 40-foot radius.**

All Council members have been brought up-to-date with these requirements. No action taken.
