### **CROSSING GUARD REGULATIONS**

According to the Millersville Borough Code Chapter 30 Educational Service Agency Section 30-7:

§ 30-7 Functions.

[Amended 3-24-1992 by Ord. No. 1992-1]

The function of the Educational Service Agency shall be to employ school crossing guards, also referred to as “**special school police**,” as provided in Section 1127 of the Borough Code, 53 P.S. § 46127 et seq., **to direct traffic** at or near schools.

According to Section 1127 of the State Borough Code, 53 P.S. 46127:

(a). Appointment:

(1). Upon request by the board of school directors of the school district in which a borough is wholly or partially located, the council may appoint school crossing guards **who shall have the duty of controlling and directing traffic** and pedestrians at or near schools and who shall be in suitable and distinctive uniform.
