ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MILLERSVILLE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 305, TO REVISE SEWER RATES.

BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Borough Council of the Borough of Millersville, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The Millersville Borough Code of Ordinances, Chapter 305, Sewers, Article I, Sewer Rates and Regulations, §305-13, Sewer Rental Rates, Subsection A, shall be amended to provide as follows:

- A. The quarterly charges for sewer service shall be at the following rates:
- (1) Effective through December 31, 2024:
 - [a] Each residential unit: \$110.00.
 - [b] Each commercial unit: \$167.30 for the first 10,000 gallons and \$4.50 for each one-thousand-gallon increment or part thereof in excess of the first 10,000 gallons.
 - [c] Millersville University. The sewer rental rates and debt service shall be in accordance with agreements from time to time in effect between the Borough and Millersville University.
 - [d] Manor Township. The sewer rental rates and debt service shall be in accordance with agreements from time to time in effect between the Borough and Manor Township.
 - (2) Effective January 1, 2025:
 - [a] Each residential unit: \$124.00.
 - [b] Each commercial unit: \$190.50 for the first 10,000 gallons and \$5.05 for each one-thousand-gallon increment or part thereof in excess of the first 10,000 gallons.

[c] Millersville University. The sewer rental rates and debt service shall be in accordance with agreements from time to time in effect between the Borough and Millersville University.

[d] Manor Township. The sewer rental rates and debt service shall be in accordance with agreements from time to time in effect between the Borough and Manor Township.

(3) Effective January 1, 2027:

[a] Each residential unit: \$139.50.

[b] Each commercial unit: \$214.00 for the first 10,000 gallons and \$5.70 for each one-thousand-gallon increment or part thereof in excess of the first 10,000 gallons.

[c] Millersville University. The sewer rental rates and debt service shall be in accordance with agreements from time to time in effect between the Borough and Millersville University.

[d] Manor Township. The sewer rental rates and debt service shall be in accordance with agreements from time to time in effect between the Borough and Manor Township.

(4) Effective January 1, 2029:

[a] Each residential unit: \$157.00.

[b] Each commercial unit: \$240.50 for the first 10,000 gallons and \$6.40 for each one-thousand-gallon increment or part thereof in excess of the first 10,000 gallons.

[c] Millersville University. The sewer rental rates and debt service shall be in accordance with agreements from time to time in effect between the Borough and Millersville University.

[d] Manor Township. The sewer rental rates and debt service shall be in accordance with agreements from time to time in effect between the Borough and Manor Township.

Section 2. All other sections, parts and provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Millersville shall remain in full force and effect as previously enacted and amended.

Section 3. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions,

sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Ordinance, it being the intent of Borough Council that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its enactment as provided by law.
