Dear Millersville Borough Resident:

Please be advised that Penn Waste has been awarded the Solid Waste and Recycling contract with Millersville Borough for the term of 1/1/25-12/31/29. We look forward to continuing to service the residents of Millersville Borough. Our goal is to provide you with superior customer service.

Please review this document for useful information regarding your collection service. We recommend placing your material curbside the evening before your collection day. Your collection day will remain the same under this contract. Your weekly collection will consist of the services below.

Under this contract, the use of a mobile cart is required. Penn Waste will be delivering mobile carts for trash service to customers on 12/16/24. Please review the contents of this flyer for more information.

Important Trash and Recycling Information for MILLERSVILLE BOROUGH RESIDENTS

Mobile Cart Information

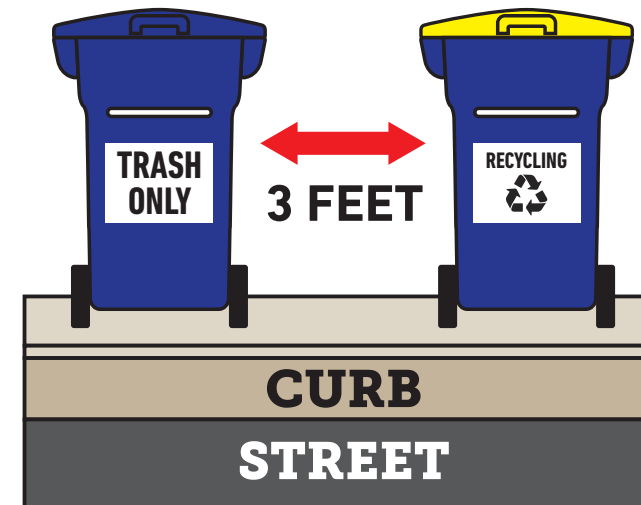
Penn Waste will be collecting trash and recycle from Millersville Borough residents with an automated truck.

The utilization of a mobile cart is required in this contract starting January 1, 2025.

Utilizing carts allows Penn Waste to provide the most efficient collection for the best price for residents. The mobile carts can also reduce the amount of litter and pests within the borough.



Proper Cart Placement



Please be advised that all mobile carts should be placed behind the curb or street line. There should be nothing placed in the roadway that would impede or delay the removal of snow or ice from the road. The garbage truck arm has the capability to reach past the curb in order to pick up your cans.

Here are some tips to ensure a smooth collection process:

- ◆ Set mobile cart out the evening before pickup day.
- ◆ Place mobile cart with the lid handle and wheels pointing toward your residence.
- ◆ Do not place cart in the roadway.
- ◆ Do not block walkways with carts.
- ◆ Place carts at least THREE FEET APART from each other and mailboxes, fire hydrants, low hanging trees or shrubs, parked cars, or utility poles - so trucks can easily access the cart.

Bulk Item Guidelines & White Goods Collection



Millersville Borough residents may dispose of two (2) bulk items per week. A tag must be purchased from the borough office and placed on the item for collection.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS – Small appliances, furniture, mattresses, box springs, lawn mowers (oil and gasoline removed), plumbing fixtures such as toilets and sinks, three (3) 4 ft. rolls of carpet (must be tied), batteries in battery bags.

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS – Electronic devices, chemicals, stains, liquids, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/industrial waste, construction materials (drywall, brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete). **Large home appliances and tires will only be collected on white goods pickup dates (see calendar).**

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS – Items which are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

Millersville Borough collects white goods twice a year: once in the spring and once in the fall. Please refer to the calendar for pickup dates.

White goods are large home appliances such as clothes washers and dryers, stoves, water heaters, etc. During white good collection, we also accept car tires with or without the rim.

Recycling Guidelines

What Goes in the Bin?

1



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD
Includes packing and shipping boxes with fluted sheet.

2



PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS
Includes plastic with a neck.

3



METAL FOOD & BEVERAGE CANS
Includes food and beverage cans made from aluminum or tin.

4



GLASS
Includes clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars.

TIPS to RECYCLE RIGHT

- ✓ Remove lids
- ✓ NO plastic bags
- ✓ No other materials than listed
 - No pots
 - No wire hangers
 - No foil
 - No cutlery

- ✓ Items must be empty and rinsed out
- ✓ Flatten cardboard

Observed holidays are noted in RED. Collection days that fall on or after the holiday will be delayed one day. EXCEPTION: If holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there is no change in service prior to or after the holiday.

BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- Trash, Recycling, bulk item(s) and yard waste (see calendar above for scheduled dates) must be curbed side by the evening before your scheduled collection day.
- All trash must fit within the provided mobile trash cart in order to be collected.
- Extra bags require a yellow tag.
- Bulk items that are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted.
- No construction debris will be collected curbed side.
