**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILLERSVILLE REESTABLISHING AND AMENDING FEES FOR SERVICE ESTABLISHED BY THE BOROUGH

WHEREAS, upon consideration of the costs involved in administering the Zoning Ordinance of Millersville Borough and other governing Ordinances, the Borough Council of Millersville Borough desires to establish reasonable fees; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council desires to establish such fees and costs effective January 1, 2026 and thereafter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by Borough Council of the Borough of Millersville, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The Millersville Borough Fee Schedule set forth in Article I, Fee Schedule, of Chapter A-395, Fees, of the Code of Ordinances, § A395-14, Other Borough Fees, shall be amended to provide as follows:

F. Application for Handicap Parking Sign: \$50

Section 2. The Millersville Borough Fee Schedule set forth in Article IV, Collection and Disposal of Solid Waste and Recyclable Materials, of Chapter A-395, Fees, of the Code of Ordinances, § A395-27 , Basic Services Provided to Borough Customers; Billing, shall be amended to provide as follows:

The service charge for Borough refuse and recyclable collection and refuse disposal services from January 1 to December 31 of each calendar year shall be in the amount of \$97 per quarter. The service charge shall be a minimum service charge for collection of source-separated recyclable materials and collection and disposal of refuse, for which the maximum removal of refuse is three thirty-two-gallon containers or one ninety-six-gallon refuse curb cart. During each calendar year, the Borough Manager or the Manager's designee shall bill each owner or owners of each Borough customer property in the Borough for the service charge.

Section 3. The Millersville Borough Fee Schedule set forth in Article IV, Collection and Disposal of Solid Waste and Recyclable Materials, of Chapter A-395, Fees, of the Code of Ordinances, § A395-28 , Additional Service Tags, shall be amended to provide as follows:

- A. Oversized item (red) tags can be purchased at a cost of \$6 each. Each oversized (bulky) waste item must have a separate oversized item tag affixed to it. No more than two bulky waste items may be placed for collection each week. Each bulky waste item must be placed for collection at the same time as solid waste and recyclable material collection.
- B. Extra refuse container (yellow) tags can be purchased at a cost of \$2 per tag, sold only in sheets of four tags for \$8 Each bag in excess of the three permitted bags must have a separate extra bag tag. There is no limit to the number of extra bags that can be placed out.
- C. White goods (blue) tags may be purchased at a cost of \$15 per tag. White goods (appliances) may be placed at curbside for collection one of the two dates each calendar year for collection of white goods and tires.
- D. Yard waste (green) tags can also be purchased at a cost of \$2 per tag, sold only in sheets of four tags for \$8. Yard bags with a tag attached may be used for disposal of yard waste.

Section 4. Severability. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses, or parts of this Resolution, it being the intent of Borough Council that the remainder of the Resolution shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Repeals and Reaffirmation of Other Fees. All provisions of Borough resolutions establishing fees for the items set forth in this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with the fees established by this Resolution. All Borough Resolutions imposing fees for items which are not addressed in this Resolution shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force on January 1, 2026.
