AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF MILLERSVILLE TO ADD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS FOR STREETS WITHIN AND SERVING THE LAFAYETTE PLACE DEVELOPMENT.

BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Borough Council of the Borough of Millersville, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Millersville, Chapter 350, Vehicles and Traffic, §350-10, Maximum Speed Limits on Certain Streets, Subsection A, shall be amended to add the following streets in alphabetical order:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Miles Per Hour</u>
Bunker Hill	Chamberlain Lane to terminus	25
Chamberlain Lane	Lynne Lane to terminus	25
Lynne Lane	Millersville Road to Chamberlain Lane	25

Section 2. The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Millersville, Chapter 350, Vehicles and Traffic, §350-22, Stop Intersections, shall be amended by inserting the following stop intersections in alphabetical order:

<u>Stop Street</u>	<u>Intersection or Through Street</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>
Bunker Hill	Chamberlain Lane	West
Chamberlain Lane	Lynne Lane	South
Lynne Lane	Millersville Road	West

Section 3. The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Millersville, Chapter 350, Article IV, Parking Regulations, §350-33, Parking Prohibited at all times in certain locations, to insert the following parking prohibitions:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
Lynne Lane	Both	Millersville Road to Chamberlain Lane

Section 4. All other sections, parts and provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Millersville shall remain in full force and effect as previously enacted and amended.

Section 5. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Ordinance, it being the intent of Borough Council that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its enactment as provided by law.
